The Madras Musical Association presents a Gospel concert by a quartet from the U.S. called 'Ernie Haase and Signature Sound' at The Music Academy on August 11, 7 p.m.

The proceeds will go in aid of Help a Child of India, a not-for-profit organisation that works for the welfare of poor and marginalised children.

Help a Child supports more than 10,000 children across 14 states, providing both residential and community-based childcare. Its interventions are mainly in the area of education, health and vocational training.

Indiana-born Ernie Haase was the former tenor singer of the Southern Gospel group 'The Cathedrals'. He became the founder of 'Ernie Haase and Signature Sound' in 2004.

Right from the group's inception, audiences responded enthusiastically to the fun and energy in their concerts, catapulting the quartet to stardom.

The male harmony group, currently nominated for a Grammy, comprises Ernie Haase, Devin McGlamery, Doug Anderson and Ian Owens with noted Southern Gospel songwriter and producer Wayne Haun serving as the pianist.

They will present popular Gospel numbers such as *Any Other Man*, *Then Came The Morning*, *Step Into The Water*, *Oh What a Saviour*, *Walk With Me*, *He Touched Me* and *When the Saints Go Marching In*. They will be backed by a four-piece band.
